**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Greene County, two-thirds of all members  
Governing body County  
elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of Miami Township (both unincorporated and incorporated areas) for the purposes of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor (including, without limitation, the Fire Station building), for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs, as authorized in Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19(I), at a rate not exceeding 0.8 mills, which amounts to twenty-eight dollars (\$28.00) for each \$100,000 of the County Auditor's appraised value, commencing in 2026  
and appearing on the tax list for a continuing period of time \_\_\_\_\_.

**RESOLUTION TO PLACE A MORATORIUM ON ANY NEW DATA CENTER  
ATTEMPTING TO OPERATE/LOCATE IN MIAMI TOWNSHIP, GREENE COUNTY,  
AND WAIVING THE SECOND READING**

**WHEREAS**, data centers—defined for the purposes of this Resolution as a physical room, building, or facility that primarily houses infrastructure for building, running, delivering, or transmitting technological applications and services, or for storing and managing the data associated with those technological applications, equipment, and/or services—have become a controversial topic in Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, the effects on local political subdivisions remain to be seen; and

**WHEREAS**, study must be done on the impacts on health, safety, utilities and infrastructure.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Miami Township Board of Trustees, Greene County, Ohio,

**Section 1.** To place a twelve (12) month moratorium on the operation/location of any new data center in Miami Township to allow time to assess data center impacts on health, safety, utilities and infrastructure.
